

Employment

Campus Employment - Work Study Program

- for on-campus students only
- primarily for foreign students who cannot work off campus
- \$950.00-\$3,500.00
- work areas: kitchen, library, security, dorm supervisors, cleaners
- some scholarships will interfere with extra-curricular activities
- application and all forms due by July 1

Off-Campus Employment

- numerous job opportunities posted on campus bulletin board
- list of prospective employers included in registration packet

Grants

CONDITIONS:

- Grant recipients must be full-time students, with the exception of the spouse grant.
- The total grants per student must not exceed 40% of tuition (with the exception of the Foreign Missionary Child Grant and the Spouse Grant). Partial grants may be used to reach this amount.
- To receive a grant for a second, third, or fourth year, a student must have a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- Grants are limited to eight semesters per student.
- Any student placed on disciplinary probation may forfeit grant funds.
- If a student withdraws from the College before the completion of the school year, the full amount of the grant is forfeited.

Alumni Child Grant

- for every child of an alumnus (one who attended Gateway for one or more semesters and earned one or more credits)
- \$1,000.00 per year
- must provide alumnus' name (maiden if applicable) and year(s) of attendance

Foreign Missionary Child Grant

- for every child of a current UPCI foreign missionary
- full tuition grant
- for on-campus students only

Home Missionary Child Grant

- for every child of a current UPCI home missionary (must be considered officially on home missions status by the Home Missions Division of the UPCI)
- \$1,000.00 per year, offered a minimum of two years
- for on-campus students only

Sibling Grant

- for every student who has a sibling currently attending Gateway College full-time
- \$500.00 per year

Spouse Grant

- for the spouse of a current full-time Gateway College student (one grant per married couple)
- half of tuition
- all other fees and expenses must be paid in full

Tupelo Children's Mansion Grant

- for any recommended graduate of Tupelo Christian Academy
- \$1,000.00 per year
- for on-campus students only

Scholarships

Gateway Funded Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of:

- Academic excellence
- Consistent good character and spiritual conduct
- Financial need

Unless listed otherwise, application forms are available from:

These documents are required for all scholarships awarded by Gateway College: (Exception: see ACT/SAT Scholarships)

- Scholarship application
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (www.fafsa.ed.gov) (to determine financial need)
 - Request a copy of the Student Aid Report. It may take several days for you to receive it. Send Gateway a copy of your SAR. A current copy is required every year that you apply for a scholarship.
- For incoming students - application for admission (and all of its supporting documents as listed on the application)
- For returning students - copy of current Gateway transcript and current Gateway tithes report

NOTE: It is the applicant's responsibility to see that all documents arrive by the deadline (April 1 unless stated otherwise). You may call or e-mail us to find out if all of your documents have arrived, but we will not call you to request documents.

- Students must carry a full-time academic load (at least 12 credit hours) to be eligible for scholarships.
- Grade point average (GPA) requirements are based on a 4.0 scale.
- Generally only one Gateway-funded scholarship can be awarded per student, but students may apply for all for which they are eligible.

CONDITIONS:

- An award letter and form is sent to each scholarship recipient. The form must be signed and returned by May 31.
- Scholarships may be deducted from the down payment.
- All scholarships granted by Gateway College are conditional upon the completion of the academic year and upon matriculation.
- If a student withdraws from the College before the completion of the school year, the full amount of the scholarship is forfeited. Scholarships are credited to the student's account at the end of each academic year.
- Scholarships may be forfeited at any time because of undesirable conduct or failure to maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- Any student placed on disciplinary probation may forfeit all institutional financial assistance.

ACT/SAT Scholarships (FAFSA not required)

- automatically given to all incoming students with an ACT score of 30 or an SAT score of 1340 (SAT math + critical reading)
- for current students who retake the test, raise scores to the required level, and apply for the scholarship (not retroactive)
- full tuition
- for on-campus students only
- renewable annually with 3.5 cumulative GPA (automatic renewal w/continuous 3.5 CGPA, otherwise student must reapply)
- application may be done at any time and will be effective for the next semester (not the current semester)

Alumni Scholarship

- for one child (either incoming or returning student) of an alumnus (one who attended Gateway for one or more semesters and earned one or more credits)
- \$1,000.00
- minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- minimum 20 ACT or 950 SAT (SAT math + critical reading)
- for on-campus students only
- must provide alumnus' name and year(s) of attendance
- application and all forms due by April 1

- minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA

- October 15 deadline (awarded in January)

Missouri Youth Division Scholarships

- for one or more Missouri students (either incoming or returning)
- application must be obtained from the Missouri District Youth Division (www.Moyouth.com) and returned there
