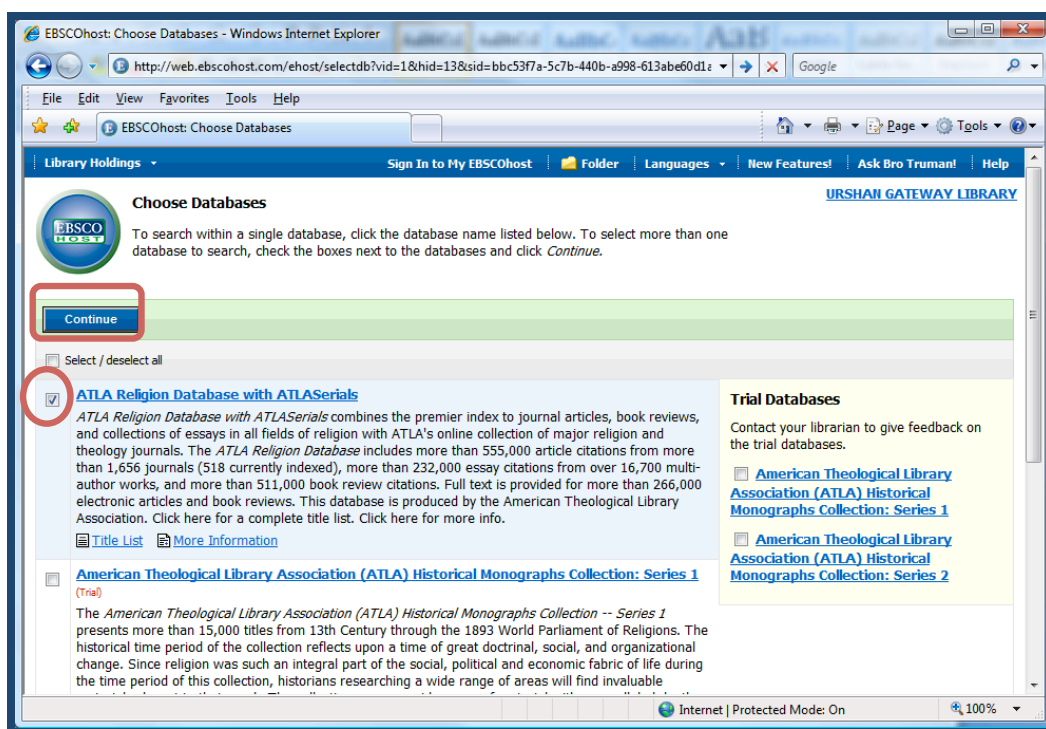
Guide to the Library's Online Journal Articles

Since research is an important part of your academic journey, the following handout is designed to help you easily find credible academic sources. While we are often tempted to merely google whatever topic we're researching, it's safer and generally more effective to use scholarly sources. Going through the safety of the library and its online databases of electronic sources is the ideal means of finding research.

The following portals take you to a collection of scholarly journal articles, which are peer-reviewed and ideal for academic research. These are the two most common forms of sources and should meet the majority of your research needs at Gateway and beyond.

For Researching Religious Topics

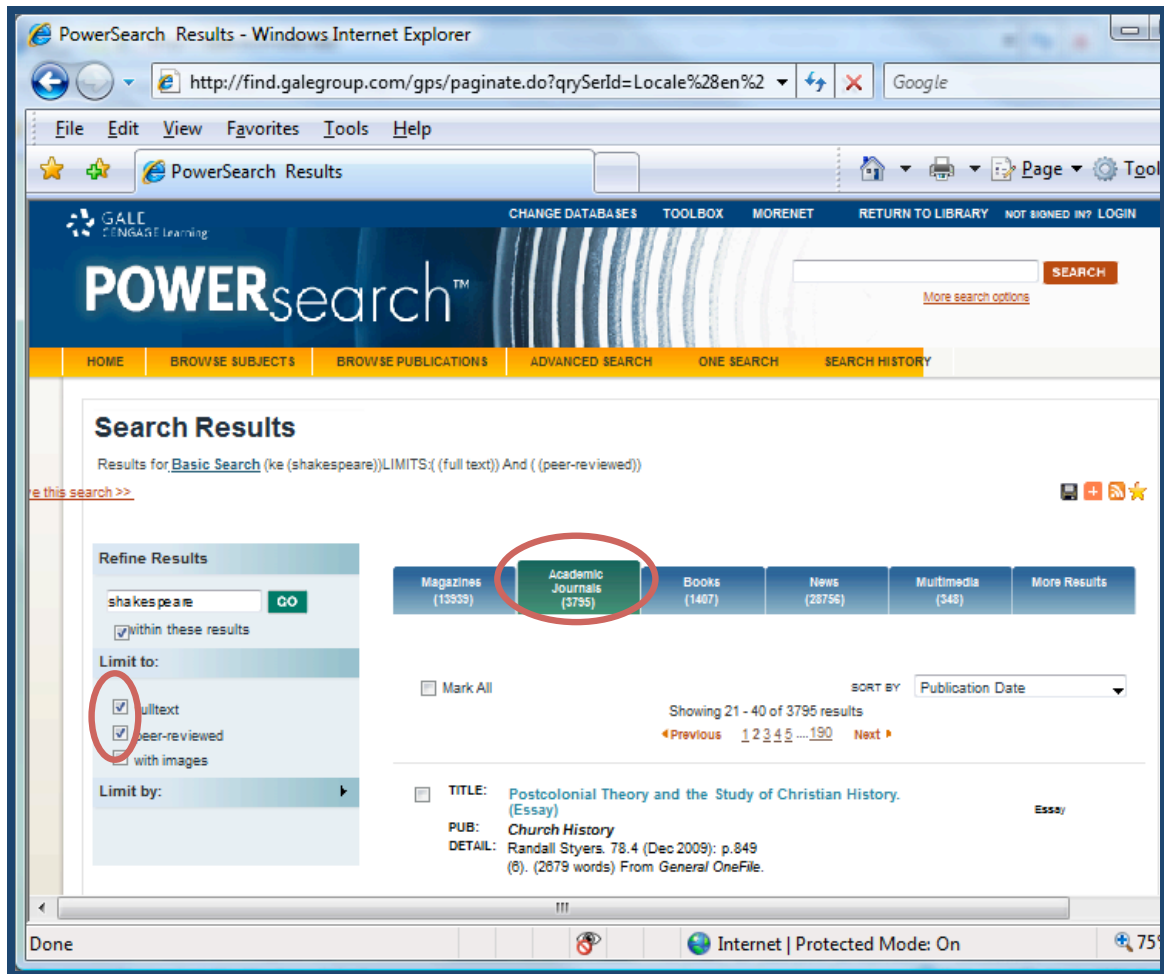
1. Go to <http://search.ebscohost.com>.
2. If prompted, enter **urshangateway** for the login and **library** for the password.
3. Check *ATLA Religion Database with ATLASerials* and click *Continue*.



4. Enter search info and click *Search*.

For Researching Non-Religious Topics

1. Go to <http://search.more.net>.
2. Enter search info and click *Go*.
3. If prompted, enter **morenet** for the password.
4. Type in search criteria and click *Go*.
5. Check the *fulltext* checkbox and the *peer-reviewed* checkbox on the left side of the search page. Then click the *Academic Journals* tab.
